Background

There is no doubt that the loss of this bridge will cause many problems for the residents on the western side of the Patawalonga as well as visitors to the area and other people passing through the Holdfast Bay area. At a suggested cost of at least \$7,000,000 it is beyond the ability of the City of Holdfast Bay to fund this on its own without significant financial consequences to its ratepayers and residents of whom many are retired and unable to meet this cost and this for a bridge which carries at least 70% of traffic which neither arises from the City of Holdfast Bay or is terminating in the City of Holdfast Bay. It is, I consider reasonable to ask for the rest of the community to contribute towards the cost of infrastructure they use through the Federal and State Governments.

Chief Executive Officer's comment

Council on 12 February 2008 resolved the following:

"C120208/031......That the City of Holdfast Bay apply for Federal and State funding to replace the King Street Bridge, in time for the funding rounds, and relevant Federal and State Government grants."

"C120208/032...... That the Council considers including the sum of \$10,000 (in the 2008/2009 budget) towards engaging a contractor to apply for Federal and State funding to replace the King Street Bridge."
