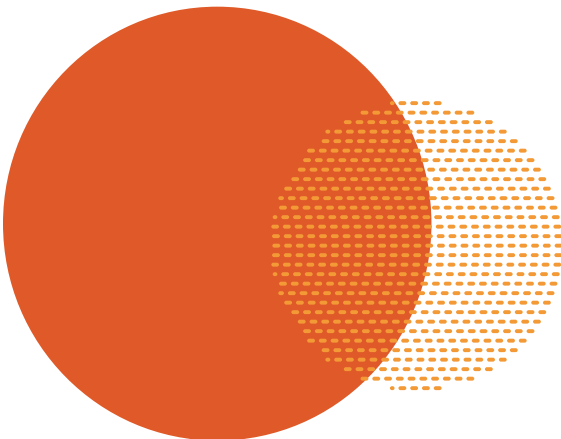

Rugless Tce, Glenelg East

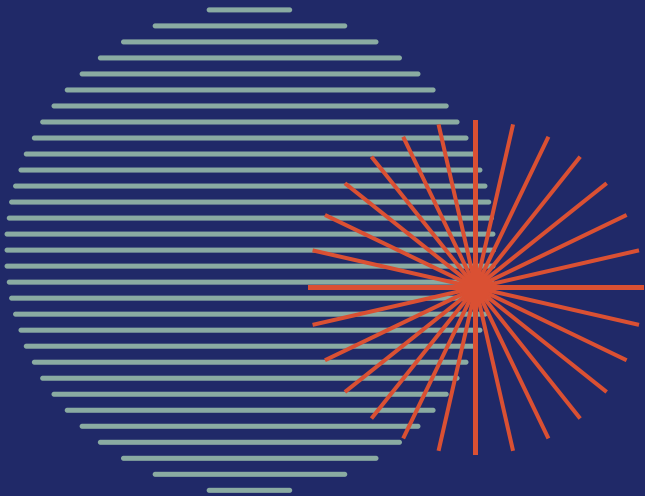
