TRANSPORT OPTIONS


Walk/cycle: Head to the corner of Shannon and Moten Avenues, Glenelg North.

Bus: Route 168 City to Glenelg leaving every half hour. Alight at Stop 23A Goldsworthy Cres (south side) or Stop 23 Shannon Ave (north side), then 3-5 minute walk to the planting site.


Car: Street parking is available for planters in Moten, McCann, Mattner and Leane Avenues. Please ensure residents have access to their driveways. Parking along part of Shannon Avenue verge is reserved for FoSRL volunteers as we are loading equipment to run the event.

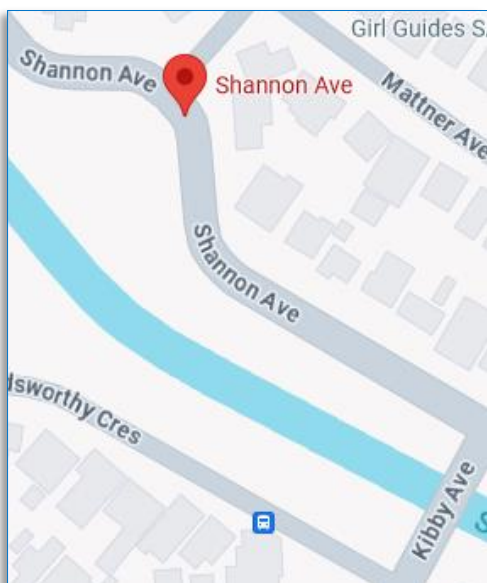
Local residents: Expect local traffic to be heavier on the day. Signage will be erected to help manage visitors and volunteers.

WHO WE ARE

We are a local not-for-profit community group, run by volunteers who live near the Sturt River. Association membership is open to individuals who share our objectives for \$10 per year.

We plant only local-native species to improve biodiversity, shade, and shelter along the Sturt River corridor, with council permission. Plants are supplied by the City of Holdfast Bay with support from a Green Adelaide grant.

WHAT TO BRING FROM HOME

- BYO small hand trowel and gloves
- BYO personal health items eg. asthma spray, diabetic bracelet
- BYO water bottle or personal snacks.

Please do not bring long-handled tools. All holes will be pre-drilled by City of Holdfast Bay.

WHAT TO WEAR

This is an outdoor event held in winter. You will be comfortable in closed, flat shoes, long pants, a long-sleeved top, sunscreen, hat, and sunglasses. Bring a light jacket in case of showers.

DETAILS

Weather: This planting will only be cancelled if the forecast is for heavy rain, winds or lightning strike. If light/clearing showers are forecast, we will go ahead as planned. We will email you prior to the planting day and post an alert on our [facebook page](#) if we need to cancel due to bad weather.

Toilets: Portaloos will be provided.

Children: All children must be supervised by a parent/s or guardian over 18 years of age, at all times.

OH&S: Please follow all directions given by event organisers.
